Class Composition:

- **Greetings:** Practicing self-introduction to the class. Identifying own name in Hiragana.
- **Singing Time:** Introducing Japanese songs, counting songs, songs with dance
- **Play with Words:** Book reading, word games, role play, conversation exercises by situations
- **Fun Time:** Seasonal craft, physical activities, and games
- **Word Bank:** Write new words that are learned during the class in on paper then save the paper in the treasure box.

There are cultural and seasonal events during the session. The class segments will be modified according to these events.

Session Objective:

Each class encompasses the five objectives listed below:

Reading	Sound out the words in Hiragana slowly, then read the words to grasp the meaning
Writing	Learn Hiragana letters and write the letters using the proper stroke order
Speaking	Practice using proper Japanese phrases to describe yourself (likes and dislikes, family) and vocabulary that are often used in classroom
Listening	Listen and comprehend the dialog with classmates in Japanese
Vocabulary	Days of the week; Months; Colors; Stationary; Sports; Installments; Family composition; Counting; Seasonal words
